RHI Engine Inspection Checklist

(Inspect every 100 hours or annually - whichever comes first.)

- Lubricate all lube points. Do this more frequently when operating in salt water.
- Inspect and clean spark plugs. Replace spark plugs in EFI/DFI engines every 100 hours.
- Check engine fuel filter for contaminants.
- Adjust carburetor(s) if required.
- Check engine timing set-up.
- Check corrosion control anodes. Do this more frequently when operating in salt water.
- Drain and replace gear case lubricant
- Lubricate spline on the propeller shaft.
- Check power trim fluid.
- Inspect battery.
- Check control cable adjustments.
- Remove engine deposits with Quicksilver Power Tune Engine Cleaner.
- Check tightness of bolts, nuts and other fasteners.
- Inspect all hose fittings and connections for leaks in the fuel storage and distribution system.
- Inspect for corrosion on the electrical wire connection to fuel level sending unit.
- Inspect electrical wire ground connections at deck fill fittings for corrosion.
